Lucy Beech and Edward Thomasson's choreographed group actions are developed through workshops with trained and untrained performers. At the centre of their practice is an exploration of how performance is initiated in non-theatrical environments as a tool for working through everyday problems and experiences.

For their show at OUTPOST the artists have worked with a group of nine performers of various ages to construct a carefully choreographed action for camera. With reference to line-dancing, the resulting work looks specifically at how instructions are simultaneously heard, understood and followed in an attempt to organise the relationship between the individual and the group.

Lucy Beech and Edward Thomasson have collaborated on performance projects since 2007 after leaving Chelsea College of Art and Design, London. Recent presentations of their work include 2nd Biennale de Belleville, Paris; South London Gallery; Frieze Projects at Frieze London; Barbican Theatre, London; Bloomsbury Theatre, London and Modern Art Oxford. They live and work in London.
