

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


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
Silvia Lerin is a visual artist currently living and working in Luton where she has been awarded by the Culture Trust Luton with a year studio bursary. She graduated with a BA (Hons) in Fine Art from the Polytechnic University of Valencia in 1998. She has exhibited widely and has received many awards and grants, most notably the Pollock-Krasner Foundation Grant, New York in 2013 and The Annex Collection Award in 2017.

The installation, Full Time Labyrinth she presents at Outpost gallery explores the physical and mental experience of working full-time in a lower basement of a busy hotel in London some years ago - the desire and time for creation was severely compromised - the low ceilings, the narrow passageways were all unstabiling factors. It felt difficult to escape this mind process...The sun of hope was omnipotent but always unseen during all that time.



The displayed pieces, the Labyrinth and the Sun, show different aspects of the visual scenario of her working space whilst also looking at the mental process Silvia was experiencing in relation with her time for creation as an artist.

Lerin arrived in London thanks to the Pollock-Krasner Foundation grant, and after a couple of years to finance her art career she began to work full time as an Engineering Coordinator in a busy hotel in Liverpool Street. Whilst there she was surrounded by large metallic chillers and enormous boilers, the ceiling was low and full of all sorts of conduits in different metallic colours and textures. Alongside the hum of machinery, for the artist there was a big visual impact too. The hotel discarded and scrapped on a regular basis pieces of used metal, cables and wires that Lerin collected carefully day after day for her artworks. For the artist, finding those little found objects were the highlight of her working day, saying 'the hotel was not only physically feeding me, but also providing me with precious material for my imagination. I have always been inspired by what I encounter or what surrounds me, so this place helped me form what was (and still is) my autobiographical project Engineering.'

Her practice comprises mostly of painting and installations, both based on the manipulation of the material through cuts, folds and superpositions - creating shapes until the desired balance is achieved in the work.

In this creative process, very often Lerin assembles painted canvas or materials of another nature with found objects that she can manipulate and alter. The juxtaposition of varying materials offers a diversity of textures that enriches the pieces through impressions of shadows, folds and creases. With this physical engagement Lerin investigates the expressive possibilities of the material to create works that suggest objects, places or emotions that she has experienced and that its unhurried observation triggers a reconnaissance of the object, the place or the emotion that inspired it via new paths of the imagination.

For example, in 2014, the artist found herself on a daily basis at the London Underground platforms in her goings here and there through the City, and this ironically contributed to her series 'Mind the Gap'. The shapes, colours and even litter that she encountered on her daily journeys around London inspired her profoundly, it was then she realised that the art she was creating reflected how she was living. As Lerin said: 'My art was evolving as a diary would do, with the series, the chapters and the art pieces, becoming its pages'.


